Don't miss this great opportunity for your Webelos Scout to grow in Scouting.

Scouts will learn how to prepare a camp site, to manage a campfire, camping/hiking safety and knot tying. Your Webelos will review pocketknife safety and can earn his Whittling Chip. They will learn about nature, from trees to the animals and the ecosystems we live in. At the pool, the Webelos will learn water safety, rescue techniques and attempt the BSA swim test. Scouts will learn how to select and wear water flotation devices, how to choose a paddle and how to paddle a rowboat. They will have the opportunity to shoot BB guns and participate in archery. Webelos will participate in individual as well as team sports while learning about good sportsmanship. If they choose, they may participate in a geocaching event that will reinforce the Scout Oath and Law and Outdoor Code.
