Wo-Ha-Li District Camporee

April 28-30

Location: Mineola Nature Preserve. (The Camporee will be open to the public).

Wo-Ha-Li District Camporee will host a District-wide Cross-over Ceremony like last year. Mineola Nature Preserve may be reached by state route 69 to east on Loop FM564 a few miles south of Mineola. At about 1/4-mile, turn right (south) off FM564 onto county road 2724 and continue over a mile to the Camporee campsite entrance on the right. Registration is at the campsite entrance and Camp HQ is at the Pavilion.

Registration and Fees: (Troops MUST register as a unit):

Return completed forms to East Texas Area Council office, 1331 E. Fifth St. Tyler, Texas 75701, by Friday, April 21, 2017 with fees of \$15.00 per person. ***Webelo Scouts are encouraged to attend. They will be assigned to a Troop and be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Webelos may register separately from Troops. All Webelos are welcome.***

Check-in will be at the marked campsite gateway on Friday night, April 28th, beginning at 5 pm. Scoutmasters and Senior Patrol Leaders are invited to a cracker-barrel at 8 pm. On Saturday there will be a Flag Ceremony at 8:45 am, following breakfast in the campsites. Scouts will begin activities at 9 am. Webelos and families may come Saturday, if necessary, and register any time before 6 pm. Webelos, who are not yet eligible for cross-over, can count the Camporee as a Troop visit. Staying with a Troop, means sharing the cost. Scoutmasters should take the initiative to contact your local Webelos II Den Leaders and inviting them.

Saturday activities will continue all day until 4:30 pm with a break for lunch 12:00-1:30. The Campfire program will begin at 7:00 pm after dinner. On Sunday, there will be no planned activity and Troops may leave on their own schedule after cleanup. Camp closes at 11am.

District will be hosting shooting sports activities on Saturday with troops providing an activity for the Camporee: Service Project, and Archery. All activities will start at 9 am, and the next events to be started on the hour.

Service Project: TBD. Troops should bring gloves.

Campsites: Campsites will be assigned in order, to fit troops, guests and activity, according to size into the camping area. Others will be assigned upon arrival.
